



BMBB - Bellmore Merrick Basketball Clinic Rules and Regulations

The rules and regulations below are for the BMBB Clinic participation for:

- Registered Players/participants
- Coaches
- Parents/Guardians

The BMBB Board of Directors stationed at the table during the clinic times are there to assist in the case of any questions, comments or oversight. In the event that the BOD member is not there, the clinicians (Coaches) will assist.

The rules of BMBB Clinic are:

- ALL players/participants are to have fun and learn
- ALL players/participants are required to wear their BMBB Clinic T-SHIRT, ***no exceptions!***
- ALL players/participants are required to bring their BMBB Clinic BASKETBALL, ***no exceptions!***
- ALL players/participants are required to wear sneakers during the clinic session, ***no exceptions!***
- ALL players/participants are expected to:
 - Be courteous to each other
 - Be respectful of and to coaches
 - Listen to coaches for all direction
 - Be ready to learn and participate 100% of the time
 - Always be listening for coach
- When schools are closed so is the Future Stars Clinic. BMBB follows the school calendar
- No access to the halls or anywhere in the halls. Players and parents are to stay in the gym, unless a bathroom break is necessary, a parent will accompany the player and assist as necessary. BMBB BoD member will direct the way to the bathroom
- Parents are encouraged to participate should the coaches request it. The players will work better with a family member present also
- Once the session is completed, please exit the facility as quickly as possible to allow the next session to begin on time
- Clean up ALL water bottles or garbage and place them in the garbage cans provided near the exit
- Report any issues to the BMBB BoD at the table
- Parents are asked to refrain from entering the court during teaching time, unless requested by Coach
- Parents must be present for their child, or have a suitable guardian present at the clinic session at all times
- Player's siblings and parents are expected to remain seated during the session, and no ball bouncing during the session
- Please do not distract the players/participants during instruction, as this is for their benefit
- Parents/Guardians - Water breaks are set by the coach, please do not come out and offer water to your child
